Original popular style composition (any sub-genre) for instrumental ensemble. Any combination of instruments - up to six players.

Original concert style composition for solo voice or vocal ensemble, with or without accompaniment. Composers and lyricists of modern popular music (any genre) can register in the Songwriting Critique session, to be held Saturday, November 25/17 at KPU's Surrey campus.
